Synopsis

Alice helps the good folks of Wonderland defeat the evil Queen of Hearts and banish her, so that all can live happily ever after including Alice herself, who falls in love with and marries Jack.

The Panto runs for approximately two and a quarter hours.

Audition Preparation

Actors (adults and teens) auditioning for speaking roles will be provided with a short text to read at the venue on the day. In addition:

Actors auditioning for the role of Alice will be required to sing a short excerpt from the Christina Perri song "Jar of Hearts" & learn a short choreography with our choreographer. Actors auditioning for the role of Jack will be required to sing a short excerpt from the Madness song " It Must Be Love".

Actors auditioning for the role of White Rabbit (Sonny) will be required to sing a short excerpt from the Gene Wilder song "World of Pure Imagination".

Roles

There are 17 speaking roles, plus a young peoples' chorus.

Principal Roles

Alice: Our dreamy orphan heroine (Female – teenage or youthful looking twenty

something)

Dame Cookie: Cook at the home for Lost and Unwanted Girls (Male)

Jack: The palace gardener and Principal Boy who becomes Alice's love interest (Male or

Female - similar age to Alice)

Queen: Diminutive and despotic royal villainess of Wonderland(Female)

King: Hen-pecked but kindly ruler of Wonderland (Male)

White Rabbit: Procrastinating albino Bunny (Male or Female)

Hatter: Eccentric inventor and riddler (Male or Female) **March Hare:** Hatter's comic sidekick (Male or Female)

Secondary Speaking Roles

***Doormouse:** Small and sleepy rodent (Male or Female)

*Cat: A rhyming Cheshire feline (Male or Female)

*Caterpillar: Wise old creepy-crawly (Male or Female)

Tweedle Dum: Dumb Twin of Tweedle Dee (Male or Female)

Tweedle Dee: Dumb, but not as dumb as Tweedle Dum (Male or Female)

*Ms Hackett Cruel owner of the orphanage (Female)

*Brandy: Orphan at Ms Hackett's Home (Female - teenage)

*Stella: Orphan at Ms Hackett's Home (Female - teenage)

*Sherry: Orphan at Ms Hackett's Home (Female - teenage)

*Some of these roles will be combined with chorus work.

The chorus are Wonderland creatures and monsters.

There may be opportunities for a few to have nonspeaking featured roles.

Chorus members will be required to dance in two song numbers during the show and to sing and dance, along with the rest of the cast, in the grand finale.

The chorus includes children aged 9 -12 years. The BEPG Committee expects that the parents or guardians of junior chorus members commit to their supervision at the later run-through rehearsals and in the theatre both for rehearsals and performances. This can be done by agreement between the families as to who will take which days. However, it is essential that all supervisors of the children attend the full run-throughs and theatre rehearsals so they know when and where the children should be. The cast dressing rooms are on a different floor to the theatre stage and so younger children need supervision to make sure that they are at the right place at the right time. The cast and crew are all fully occupied during the show and cannot be responsible for supervising children or young people.

Registration

You should arrive 15 minutes before the starting time, for registration and so that your photo can be taken. The auditions will include a warm up, some simple group dancing exercises, singing and acting for auditionees trying out for a principal role. Those who are given auditions for the principal roles should be prepared to sing a solo if their character has a solo or duet. We will try to ensure that children under 12 will be ready to be collected promptly at the end of the assigned audition period.

Roles will be confirmed by 28th August 2021, after which the script will be distributed and the cast are required to read and learn their scripts from then on.

By registering your interest in being part of the Panto, you also agree to the following:

- 1. You will behave with respect at all times to your fellow cast and crew in the rehearsals and in the theatre. This applies to all cast and crew.
- 2. You will remember that the show is the most important thing. You will be responsible for your own behaviour in terms of time management and attendance at all required rehearsals.
- 3. In case of any disputes, the decision of the directors is final.

Rehearsals will be at the Panto Cellar, as in previous years, and start the week beginning Monday, 30th August and will usually be on Tuesday and Thursday evenings. All cast members should be at the Cellar for 18.50 to join in a short warm-up before the rehearsal which will be from 19.00-21.00.

Whenever possible we will structure rehearsals so that the junior chorus can leave at 20.00. There may be some weekend rehearsals. Notice of these will be given well in advance. Due to the amount of material we require a high commitment to the rehearsals and unannounced attendances will not be tolerated.

We also need help with:

Backstage crew / Backstage marshalling of artists / Set construction & painting / Costumes / Make-up / Advertising Copy Design / Programme design & setting / Props / Lights & sound/ Front of House

We are particularly interested to hear from parents of junior chorus members who might, themselves, want to use the rehearsal time gainfully and aid the directors by engaging in activities such as prompting or reading in parts for absent cast members.
